**Timothy Murphy**, B.M., M.M., (organ performance), teaches jazz piano at the Peabody Conservatory of Music and Towson University. He has performed and recorded extensively with such musicians as Woody Shaw, Greg Osby, Curtis Fuller, Dennis Chambers, Antonio Hart, Charlie Rouse, Gary Thomas, Pat Metheny, Terri Lyne Carrington, John Scofield, and others. He has been organist at St. Ignatius Roman Catholic Church in Baltimore since 1983, and is host of *The Morning Jazz Show* on WYRE.

**Ronald Stolk** obtained degrees in organ and church music from the Royal Conservatory in The Hague, the Netherlands, where he studies with Johann Th. Lemckert. He continued his studies with Jean Langlais and Gaston Litaize in Paris, and followed courses at the International Summer Academy for Organists in Haarlem. He has won several prizes and awards, including the J.S. Bach Prize of the City of Wiesbaden (Germany), a Tournemire Medal at St. Albans (England), First Prize in the San Anselmo CA Competition, and First Prize in the American Guild of Organists National Competition in Organ Improvisation. He is dean of the District of Columbia Chapter of the AGO and an organist liaison for the National Association of Pastoral Musicians.
